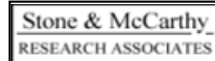
10am ET Census Bureau releases revised historical data for Orders, Shipments and Inventories.

We estimate orders slipped 0.3% lower after the most recent report of a 3.7% increase in March. Note that revised historical data back to 2000 will be released at 10:00 AM on Friday, May 18, which may conceivably affect our estimate for April."]
